Academic Excellence - Calvin's academic success is excellent—achieving a 23.9 composite ACT score this past year—the highest among area Christian schools. 96% of our graduating class are continuing their education in college. And, almost all staff have advanced degrees or are pursuing advanced degrees. Calvin Christian High School (CCHS) has a 1:1 laptop initiative—allowing students to gain 21st Century digital media literacy and to connect and collaborate both on campus and across the globe in meaningful projects. Calvin's excellent Educational Support Services strives to meet the needs of all students. AP Courses and STEM emphasis courses available. Our small school size allows us to meet the needs of individual students building close relationships and getting to know each learner.

Student Population - We are blessed with a student population of 338 this year; 15 of those students are international students from China, Taiwan and South Korea. Our international club offers a chance for American and International students to fellowship and learn from one another. In addition, the Across the Globe team, which serves locally as well as takes a trip to Africa each year, plans to travel to Guatemala in December. In addition to international travel opportunities, students have opportunities to travel domestically too. - Enrollment Deadline is June 1 for the upcoming school year



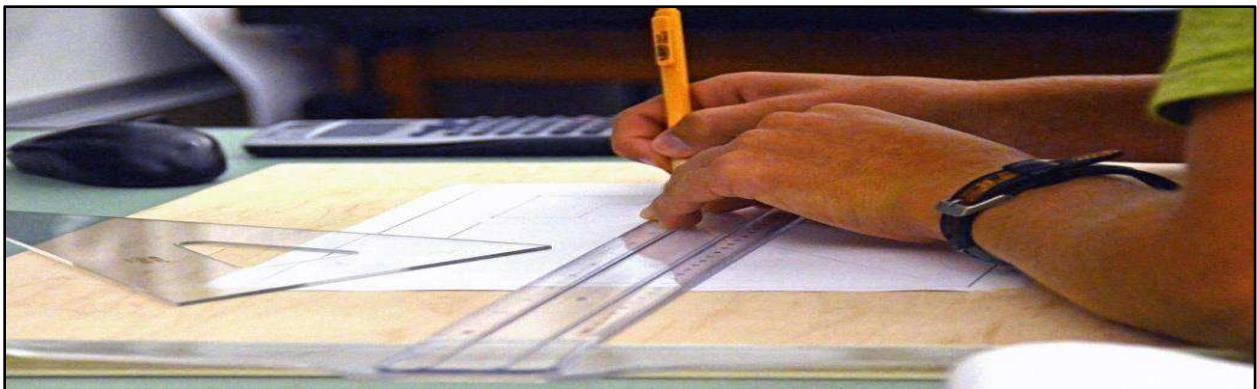
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- Seniors may enroll for a diploma if they have studied in the U.S. as a high school student in a prior year.
- **Graduation Requirements** – 22 credits (4 math – 4 English – 3 science – 3 social studies – 2 world language – .5 technology 1 art/fine/applied)

Application and Registration Process

- Complete the online application and submit to Thelma Ensink, Principal, tensink@gccsmi.org
- Interview - Our school will contact you for a Skype Interview
- Acceptance - upon successful application and interview, acceptance will be awarded with detailed instruction
- Tuition - Tuition, homestay and service fees will be received by the school prior to issuing the I20
- Host Family Match - each student will be matched with a local host family
- Orientation - Students shall arrive prior to August 19, 2017 and be prepared for orientation the week of August 21, 2017
