

THE CALVIN CHRISTIAN ELEMENTARY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Calvin Christian Elementary School Endowed Scholarship is awarded annually through the Grandville Calvin Christian Schools (GCCS) in memory of Calvin Christian Elementary School (CCES) in Wyoming.

Scholarship Objective:

To provide \$500 scholarships to Calvin Christian Middle and High School students who demonstrate Christian character, maturity, leadership, service, and solid academic performance. This scholarship reward is meant to be based on student merit alone, not on financial need or parental involvement.

Applicant Qualifications:

1. Student must be an incoming eighth or eleventh grader at CCSA (apply during 7th or 10th grade year).
2. Student must be a former CCES student or a City of Wyoming resident.
3. Student must have a minimum of 2.8 GPA or equivalent.
4. Student must seek and submit a letter of recommendation from one CCSA teacher or faculty member **AND** their church pastor or youth minister.
5. Student must write and submit an essay (name printed on the back side of the essay).
6. Student must have completed the required school service hours appropriate to their grade level.

Governance Details:

1. Monies for the scholarship will be from interest earned.
2. Surplus interest will be added to principle to allow the fund to grow.
3. Additional gifts to this scholarship will be added to principle of the fund.
4. More \$500 scholarships can be added once the interest level is reached to provide scholarships in increments of two, equally at middle and high school levels.
5. Students may receive the scholarship only once.
6. Students may apply in both their middle and high school years.
7. Selection Committee will create new essay question each year based on Christian character, maturity, leadership, or service themes.
8. Final determination for winner will be based on essay.
9. Application forms, details, and promotion of scholarship shall be made available by March 1, and application due date shall be May 1.
10. Winner(s) announcement and awards dated shall be May 31.

Selection Committee:

1. Minimum number of 3 and maximum of 5 members.
2. Minimum two-year commitment.
3. Members to include: one middle school faculty member, one high school faculty member, one board member, and one parent.

In the event that GCCS ceases to exist, all remaining funds for this scholarship shall be donated to any Christian School International (CSI) school(s) with the Wyoming community.
