During chapel this week, we were privileged to have GCS PE teacher, Mr. Ryan Krombeen, come and share with us how he's been able to worship fully through his involvement in sports. Mr. Krombeen shared with us a verse that is meaningful to him: "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others" (Philippians 2:3). We learned from him that oftentimes in sports, we can let our own pride take center stage and fail to show humility to others. It was interesting to observe our middle school students shaking their heads in agreement and recognizing this as a reality in their own lives when they compete in a variety of arenas.

But as Mr. Krombeen spoke, I started thinking about our own lives as adults. How well are we doing in living this verse out? Are we looking toward the interests of others in addition to our own? Are we approaching one another with humility in our interactions or are we finding ourselves more on the pride end of the spectrum? One of the things I appreciate about being a part of a Christian school community is that we are challenged daily to live in an authentic Christian community. In order to do that, it requires us to seek humility. That's not a practice we see often in our world today, and I'm thankful for the reminder from Mr. Krombeen this week that it's what we should be doing.
